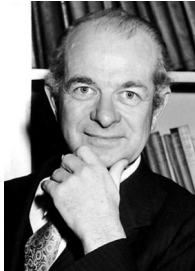

July 9 9:30AM OSU Bee Lab Tour Corvallis

OSU Professor Emeritus, Michael Burgett, world renown expert on honey bees, will lead a tour of the OSU Honey Bee Research Lab and explain the research and teaching roll of the lab. He will tell about his world-wide travels and experiences as a leader in bee research around the world. July 16 9:30AM FIELD TRIP: Linn County Historical Museum & Moyer House Brownsville

The museum features exhibits & collections dating from early settlement to the 1940's. It captures the essence of early life in the county. The Moyer House, an Italianate Villa style, is an elegant home completed in 1881. It has been restored to its original glory. The class will meet in the parking lot of the First Congregational Church, United Church of Christ, 4515 SW West Hills Rd. and caravan to the museum at 9:30 AM. The museum is located at 101 Park Ave, Brownsville. We will be divided into two groups, alternately touring the house and the museum.
